Understand the World

- Compare a seaside location to where we live- Similarities and differences.
- Explore language relating to coast- beach, cliff, sea, weather
- Comparing weather in different countries- Climates
- Theme: Special Places: Key Question: What makes places special? Religions: Christianity, Islam, Judaism
- Noah's Ark

Provision Links
